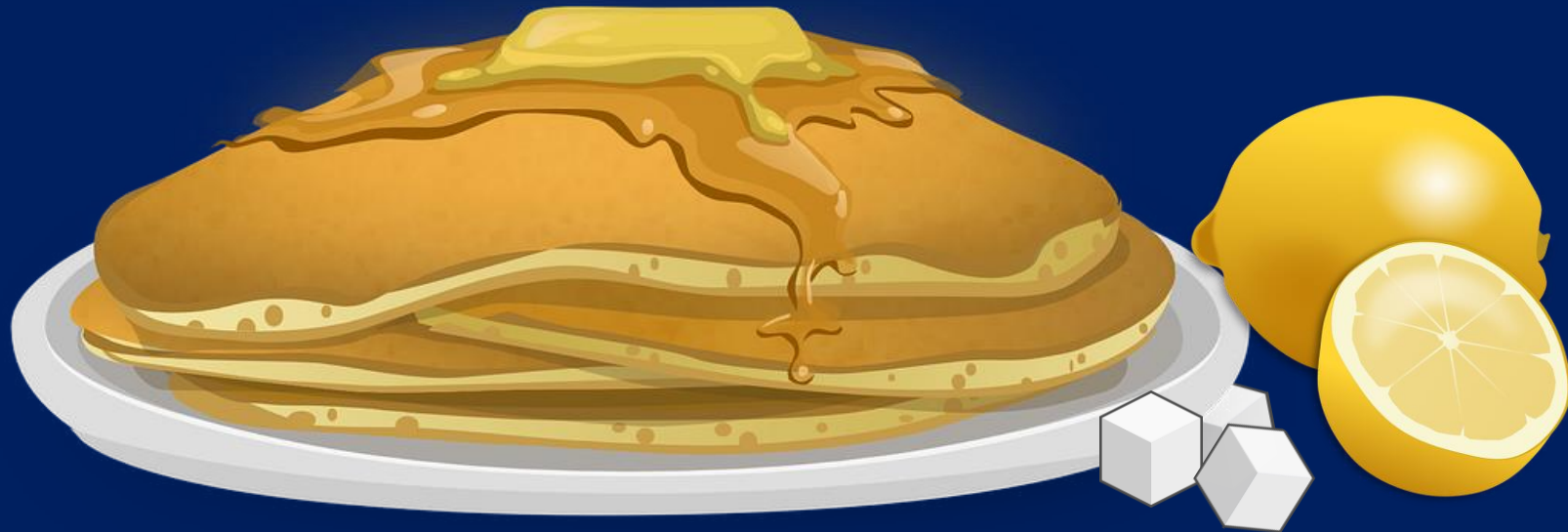


Halloween is a fun celebration.

inside.





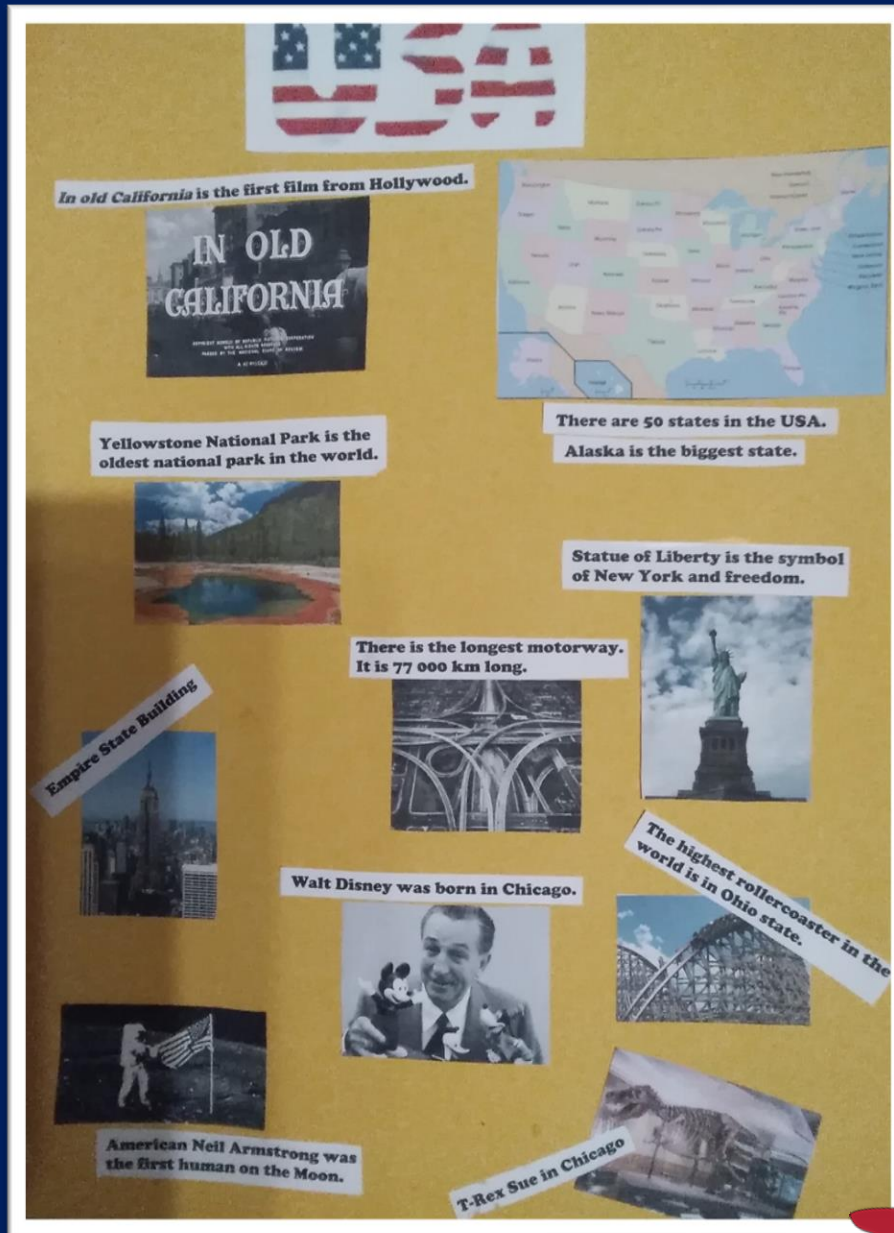
Shrove Tuesday is 40 days before Easter. People eat the pancakes with sugar and lemon.
In the old days, British people needed to use up their butter and eggs because they didn't eat them for the 40 days of Lent.

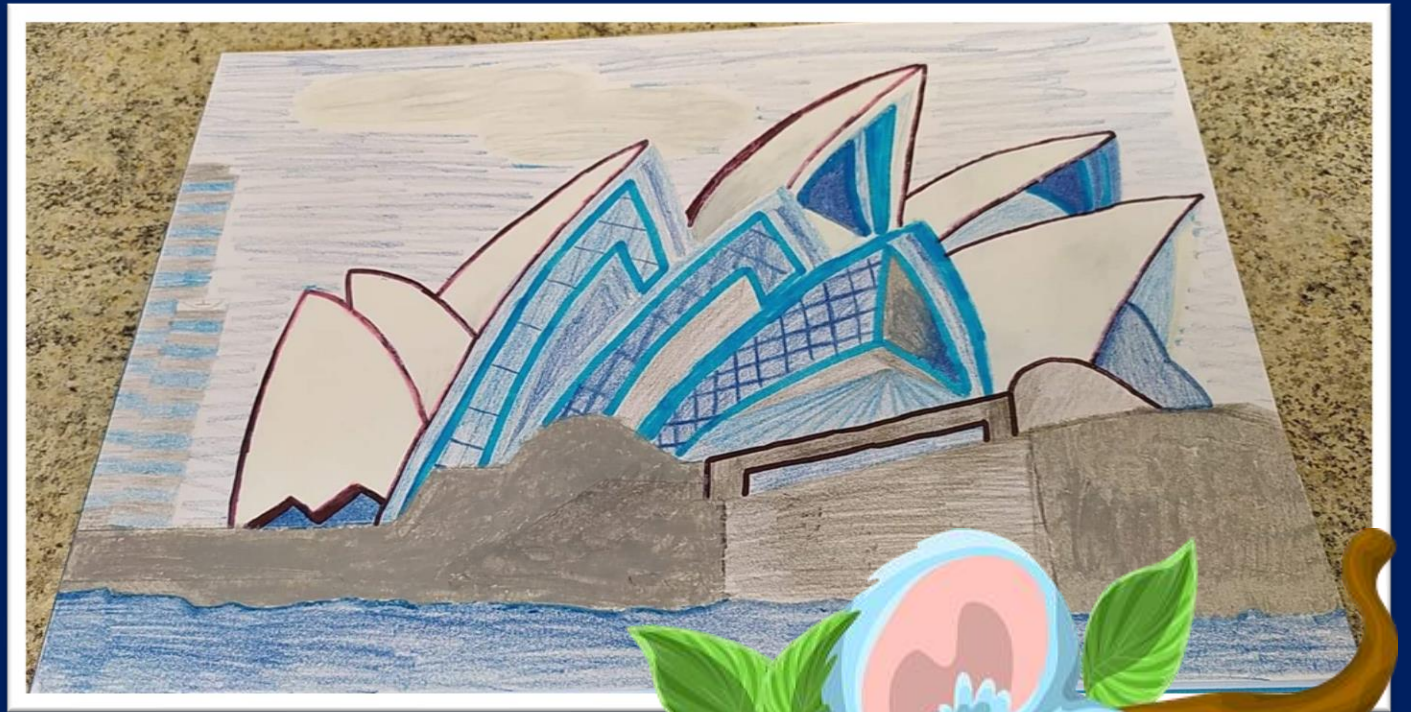




Bonfire Night
